

## Fall 2025 SFL Community Report Executive Summary

### Academics

- The fall 2025 All-SFL GPA of 3.454 is above the All-KU average of 3.354.
  - This is a **0.58% increase** from the fall 2024 All-SFL GPA of a 3.434.
  - The All-SFL GPA has been above the All-KU GPA for **11 consecutive semesters**.
- 20 chapters semester GPA is above the All-KU average of 3.354
  - Last fall, there were also 20 chapters above the All-KU average.
- The fall 2025 All-Sorority GPA of 3.542 is above the All-Undergraduate Female GPA of a 3.454.
  - This is an **0.85% increase** from the fall 2024 All-SFL GPA of a 3.434.
- The fall 2025 All-Fraternity GPA of 3.243 is above the All-Undergraduate Male GPA of a 3.236.
  - The All-Fraternity GPA is the exact same as the fall 2024 All-Fraternity GPA.

### Education and Leadership Development

- The executive boards for the Interfraternity Council (IFC), the Multicultural Greek Council (MGC), the National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC), and the Panhellenic Association (PHA) all transitioned officers in November. SFL hosted the Officer Installation Ceremony to celebrate the outgoing and incoming leaders of our community.
- The Eta Epsilon chapter of Order of Omega National Greek Honor Society was reactive in November with 42 re-founding members.
- IFC partnered with Beers Aren't Bad to provide education to chapters about reduced and safe alcohol consumption.
- MGC hosted their neo retreat for new members of the community who joined in the spring of 2025 in August to assist in acclimating them to the MGC experience.
- In September, NPHC energized campus with its semesterly NPHC Week, featuring Meet the Greeks, a Study Night, a Soul Food fundraiser, Game Night, Bowling Night, Plot Cleanup, and an exciting Field Day. The week highlighted scholarship, service, and community while bringing students together in meaningful and fun ways.
- PHA hosted a collaborative event combining sisterhood and philanthropy, raising over \$1,500 for the Boys and Girls Club of Lawrence.

### Recruitment, Retention & Expansion

- The All-SFL first year freshman member retention is 94.7% All-KU first-time freshmen retention of 87.5% and the non-SFL member first year freshmen retention of 84.7%.
  - This is a **1% increase** from the SFL retention rates from last year 93.7%.
- The SFL community totaled 4,875 members during the fall 2025 semester. This includes 3,391 sorority members and 1,484 fraternity members.
  - The overall community experienced a **12% increase** from fall 2024 (4,342 members).
  - The sorority community experienced an **11.2% increase** from fall 2024 (3,049 members).

- The fraternity community experienced a **14.77% increase** from fall 2024 (1,293 members).
- Council growth is as follows:
  - IFC: **15.40% increase** from fall 2025 (1,416) vs fall 2024 (1,227).
  - MGC: **12.90% decrease** from fall 2025 (125) vs fall 2024 (155).
  - NPHC: **31.48% increase** from fall 2025 (71) vs fall 2024 (54).
  - PHA: **11.94% increase** from fall 2025 (125) vs fall 2024 (155).
- Currently, **22.6%** of the University of Kansas students are members of a fraternity or sorority.
  - This is a **1.8% increase** from 20.8% in fall of 2024.
- 17 of the 18 IFC fraternities welcomed 381 new members this fall.
  - This includes 21 new members who joined Sigma Chi, who returned as an active and recognized chapter.
  - This is a **5.24% increase** from fall 2024 (381, with 17/17 chapters welcoming new members).
- Four of the six of the MGC fraternities and sororities brought in 29 new members this fall.
  - This is a **45.28% decrease** from fall 2024 (35, with 6/6 chapters welcoming new members).
- Three of the eight NPHC fraternities and sororities brought in 11 new members this fall.
  - With their fall intake class, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Incorporated, is active and recognized again.
  - This is a **60.71% decrease** from fall 2024 (28, with 7/7 chapters welcoming new members).
- The 11 Panhellenic sororities welcomed 1,312 new members this fall.
  - This is a **29.0% increase** from fall 2024 (1,017, with 11/11 chapter welcoming new members).

### Service & Philanthropy

- During the fall 2025 semester, 37,372 hours of hands-on community service hours were completed by fraternity and sorority members. This is an average of 7.66 hours of service performed per member of the SFL community.
  - This is a **12.34% increase** from fall 2024 (33,267).
- During the fall 2025 semester, \$364,880 was raised for charities by sororities and fraternities. This is an average of \$74.84 raised per member of the SFL community.
  - This is a **44.94% increase** from fall 2024 (\$251,741.55).
