

Spring 2025 Community Report Executive Summary

Academics

- The Spring 2025 All-SFL GPA of 3.564 is above the All-KU average of 3.357.
- 21 chapters semester GPA is above the All-KU average of 3.357.
- The Spring 2025 All-Sorority GPA of 3.563 is above the All-Undergraduate Female GPA of a 3.445.
- The Spring 2025 All-Fraternity GPA of 3.311 is above the All-Undergraduate Male GPA of a 3.256.

Education, Leadership Development and Community Building

- The executive boards for the Interfraternity Council (IFC), the Multicultural Greek Council (MGC), the National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC), and the Panhellenic Association (PHA) all attended the [Association of Fraternal Leadership and Values Central Conference](#) in Indianapolis, IN in Late January.
- One member of the SFL community attended the [Undergraduate Interfraternity Institute](#) this summer.
- More than 80-chapter presidents and council executive board member participated in the SFL Advance Leadership program to learn about Roberts Rules of Order, SFL and Campus Processes and Policies, leading beyond letters, navigating burnout and developing delegation skills.
- MGC and NPHC collaborated to co-host a neo retreat for new members of the community who joined in the fall of 2025 in January to assist in acclimating them to the MGC and NPHC experience.
- New this spring SFL all president roundtables to provide a space for leaders of all chapters to share upcoming events or programs, chapter successes and engage across councils with other presidents in the community.

Recruitment, Retention & Expansion

(Note retention and graduate data are provided once a year in the fall semester. Thus, that data is same from fall 2024)

- The All-SFL first year freshman members of SFL retention are currently 93.7% compared to the All-KU first-time freshmen retention of 86.5% and the non-SFL member first year freshmen retention of 83.8%.
- The SFL community totaled 4,250 members during the Spring 2025 semester. This includes 2,971 sorority and 1,279 fraternity members.
- Currently, 21.61% of the University of Kansas students are members of a fraternity or sorority.

Service & Philanthropy

- During the Spring 2025 semester, 42,872 hours of hands-on community service were completed by fraternity and sorority members. This is an average of 10.08 hours of service performed per member of the SFL community.
 - During the 2024-2025 academic year, the SFL community performed 76,084 hours of community service.
- During the Spring 2025 semester, \$199,267.58 was raised for charities by sororities and fraternities. This is an average of \$46.89 raised per member of the SFL community.
 - During the 2024-2025 academic year, \$451,009.13 was raised for local and national philanthropic organizations by the SFL community.
