



## Stakeholder Expectations

- All Chapters will have an Advisory Board comprised of at least three advisors. One advisor must be local (within a 50-mile radius), and it is recommended Chapters over 75 members have two local advisors (within a 50-mile radius). Chapters below 75 members will have at least one advisor.
- At the beginning of each academic year, the Office of Sorority & Fraternity Life will host a New Advisor Training open to all newly appointed advisors within the last year. The purpose of this meeting will be to review SFL policies and expectations, provide campus resources, and to share best practices.
- Each semester, our Council Advisors will host council-specific meetings with their respective Chapter Advisors and House Corporation representatives. These meetings are intended to help advisors build relationships, network, and share best practices. Chapter Advisors will receive individual invitations to these roundtable meetings as they are scheduled.
- The Facilities Partners Meeting brings together housing corporation boards, house directors, and other volunteers assisting with the management of chapter facilities. The purpose is to provide a space for networking and community building between this unique group. Resources and relevant updates will be shared. These sessions will help build a support network and provide training on emergency management, crisis response, and additional University resources. This meeting will be held every summer prior to the student move-in.
- The Office of Sorority & Fraternity Life (SFL) recognizes all Chapter advisors and other sorority and fraternity chapter volunteers as integral stakeholders in the success of our undergraduate chapters. Sorority and Fraternity Life values opportunities to connect with our chapter advisors, house corporation representatives, and house directors. However, we know that connecting in person is not always feasible for all our volunteers. We encourage all our chapter advisors to feel comfortable reaching out via email or phone at any point throughout the year. We look forward to fostering and continuing a collaborative relationship with you.
