

Town and Gown Expectation

- We will be good neighbors in our community by practicing good stewardship of our properties, community, neighbors, and the University.
- As a matter of respect for the neighborhoods in which our Chapters reside, each Chapter is expected to maintain exteriors of property/facilities in a manner consistent with reasonable community standards. Written concerns regarding property upkeep must be addressed within 2 business days, and include reasonable measures to rectify the problem.
- Chapters are expected to observe community standards regarding noise and other behaviors that impact neighbors (treatment of property, foot traffic, managing gatherings, etc.). Written concerns (e.g. neighbor complaints or police reports) regarding problematic behavior must be addressed within 2 business days.
- Whether at a recognized chapter facility, local or remote venue, or location in which members are construed to represent the organization, members must respect and abide by these expectations.
- Additionally, chapters may face consequences through their respective council.
